214 Vehicle Pursuits

214.6.4 LOW SPEED INTERVENTION

Other than an approved usage of <u>the PIT</u>, police vehicles shall not be used to physically <u>block a stopped vehicle or to physically force a pursued moving vehicle off the roadway, or to a stop, or to otherwise change its direction of travel, or to alter its speed unless:</u>

- (a) The pursued vehicle is at a stop or near stop; and
- (b) The police vehicle is maneuvering at low speed; and
- (c) Doing so would reduce or eliminate the risks associated with the a pursuit beginning or continuing.

Before engaging in such actions, officers must consider the unintended consequences of the <u>low-low-speed</u> intervention and recognize that a better course of action may be to <u>allow a vehicle to leave the scene</u>, or if a pursuit has already begun, to terminate the pursuit altogether.
